

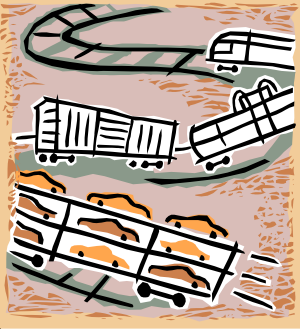

Presidents Letter September

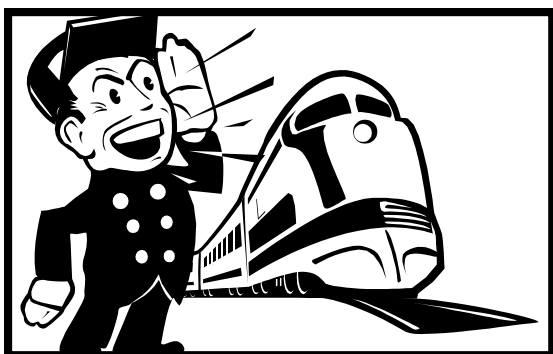
